SeniorNet

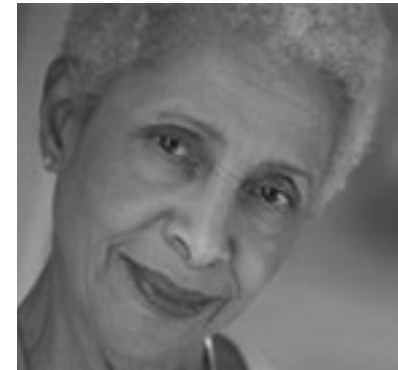
SeniorNet at OLLI-USF has specialized in computer training for older adults since 1993. These classes are small and structured to ensure hands-on instruction and personal attention. The courses are taught by a dedicated group of knowledgeable volunteers who are assisted by three to four coaches who stand by to work with students individually. SeniorNet class registrations include a trial membership in SeniorNet, the international community of computer-using older adults.
